Unit 1

Asking for recommendations.

(where) do you suggest+ (subject+ inf)?

Ex: Where do you suggest (we start)?

Do you recommend+ (n/ v.ing / subject+inf).....?

Ex: Do you recommend (a tour with a guide/ going to the bazaar)?

What's the best place to + (inf) .?

Ex: What's the best place to (buy souvenirs)?

Is there a good place to + (inf) .?

Ex: Is there a good place to eat near the museum)?

(B) Giving recommendations

I recommend (n / v.ing / subject + inf).....

Ex: I recommend (a tour / you buy a guide book)

I suggest (v+ing / that subject+ inf)

Ex: I suggest (playing football / that we play football).

The best place to + infis..

Ex: The best place to (Try traditional Egyptian food is the café opposite the museum)

You can + inf.....

Ex: you can (buy a guide book) at

the tourist information centre.

Expected situations with model answers:(WB)

1-A tourist asks you where he can buy a map. You know that the tourist information centre gives out (وزع) maps for free.

Answer: you can get a map at the tourist information centre.

2-A tourist asks you about the best place to try traditional Egyptian food.

Answer: The best place to try traditional Egyptian food is the café opposite the museum.

Unit(2)

A-) Asking about feelings

السؤال عن المشاعر

How do you feel about (.....) now? كيف تشعر بشأن الآن

Ex: How do you feel about (the story) now?

How do / did you feel (when subject + verb)?

Ex: How did you feel (when Hassan finally saw the trees)?

Did (the story) make you feel + (adjective)?

Ex: Did the story make you feel sad?

(B) Expressing feelings

التعبير عن المشاعر

I feel / felt + (adjective)

Ex: I feel /felt (frightened/ quite happy)

I don't feel + adj

Ex: I don't feel sad.

It made me feel (adjective)

Ex: It made me feel excited.

Expected situations with model answer:(WB)

1-A friend asks you what you thought of a scary film that has just finished.

Answer: I felt frightened.

2-Your friend has finished a book.

The end of the book made you feel sad. You want to know if your friend thinks the same.

Answer: Did the end of the book make you feel sad?

Unit 3

Using sequencing words

First of all. (subject + verb + object)

Ex: First of all , we clean our houses.

Next. (subject+ verb+object).

Ex: Next, we decorate our homes.

Afterwards. (subject+ verb+ object)

Ex: Afterwards, many people go shopping.

After / Before / At...

Ex: After / Before /At (dinner, children are given envelopes).

At midnight /midday

Ex: At midnight / midday (there are fireworks).

The next (day / morning / afternoon).....

Ex: The next (day / morning / afternoon, (we wear our new clothes.

Expected situations with model answer:(WB)

Expressing certainty and uncertainty

(B) To express uncertainty, we can use:

I'm not sure (he/ she /it)is..

(He / She / It)might be....

Perhaps (he/she/it) will.....

Expected situations with model answer:(WB)

Answer: I'm not sure that's right.

Adding information

In addition to doing his homework, Youssef helps his mother in the kitchen every night.

Unit 6

Emphasising a point

You must remember to +inf

Ex: You must remember to describe characters well.

You must remember that (subject+verb...)

Ex: You must remember that grammar rules are important.

Don't forget to+inf

Ex: Don't forget to come early.

Don't forget that + subject + verb

It's necessary / important to + inf

Ex: It's important to follow grammar rules.

Expected situations with model answers:(WB)

1-A friend asks you for the best way to revise before the test.

Answer: You must remember not to wait until the day before the test.

2-You are in the busy street with younger brother. You advise him not to walk too close to the road.

Answer: You must remember not to walk too close to the road.
